**Old Business:**

Foundation for Pennsylvania Watersheds: Canoe Access Project: Ed Bowman reported that vegetation has been cut and removed. Blake Thomas used an excavator to cut the path into a switch back configuration. Larry Brannaka laid out the path with flags. Donations have been received for construction of wooden benches and landscaping to be done by the Ben Fehl and his Penn State students.

BEA Conservation group: Ann Donovan reported on Science Day at Bald Eagle Area and the educational workshop at the Black Moshannon State Park. Mimi Wutz assisted Ann with the workshop. BEA students once again won the annual Envirothon at the Bald Eagle State Park. They will be competing at the State level which will be held at Johnstown.

Boggs Township Davidson Road Bridge Creek Bank Stabilization Project: David Veneziano reported a grant application was submitted in the amount of \$19,400.00. The next step will be submission for a General Permit 3.

Milesburg Front Street Project: Paul Bartley reported that an on-site visit was held after the April meeting. Larry Brannaka took pictures and plans to re-visit the site when Bald Eagle Creek is at low flow. He needs to check on the amount of bank undercut. Milesburg Borough will be applying for Growing Greener funding for the project.

**New Business:** Ann Donovan reported several projects are planned for this year by the Centre County Conservation District. Restoration work on the Decker project from 2014, stream bank stabilization at the Lucas property on Wallace Run, stream structure work at the Harader property on Little Marsh Creek, and stream bank stabilization at the Calvin property on Urlich Road.
